## Why support Veterans?

#### What do the statistics say?

In 2008, the VA estimated that about 1 in 3 Veterans visiting primary care clinics has some symptoms of depression; 1 in 5 has serious symptoms that suggest the need for further evaluation for major depression; and 1 in 8 to 10 has major depression, requiring treatment with psychotherapy or antidepressants.

The divorce rate for combat veterans is high, with a staggering 80% of combat veterans experiencing divorce. This is due to the fact that veterans are not able to return to civilian life like they were before, and injuries and mental problems are also common culprits. (From "The Soldiers Project)

About 11% to 20% of veterans have suffered from PTSD in a given year. Of the 1.9 million veterans, about 209,000 to 380,000 will be developing PTSD, says the Department of Veterans Affairs.

In 2020, there were 6,146 Veteran suicides. This was on average 16.8 per day.
In 2020, adjusting for population age and sex differences,

In 2020, adjusting for population age and sex differences, the suicide rate for Veterans was 57.3% greater than for non-Veteran U.S. adults. Among U.S. adults who died from suicide in 2020 (US Department of Veterans Affairs).

#### Ketamine-Assisted Psychotherapy (KAP):

**Legal**, psycholytic, modern, medication that is an adjunct to professional psychotherapy and proven effective for depression, anxiety, PTSD, and alcohol use disorder...



KAP has shown significant efficacy in the remission of treatment-resistant depression. It is the **only** medication effective for acute suicidality

Durability at 12 months demonstrates improved efficacy with time

#### Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation (TMS): FDA

**Approved** medication-free alternative to effective treatment of depression, anxiety, and OCD...
